Is located at the end of Camillus Pool Road in Orchard Village. The park features a picnic shelter, playground area and a wooded trail system as well as a new State of the Art Splash Pad, outdoor fitness equipment, pickle ball courts and bocce ball.

Veteran's Park at Gillie Lake...

Is located at the end of Ike Dixon Road. The park features a veteran's memorial, a seasonal beach, a fishing dock, a restored one-room school house, an agriculture museum, a playground, a walking trail and 3 picnic shelters.

Munro Park...

Is located in the village of Camillus behind the Camillus Senior Center. The park features a playground, basketball court and two baseball fields.



Shove Park...

Is located off of Slawson Drive. The park features a picnic shelter, 3 baseball fields, 2 playgrounds and the indoor Ice Arena and Parks and Recreation office.



Municipal Building...

Is located on West Genesee Street. Outside, the grounds feature a playground area and a gazebo that features the Summer Concert Series. Inside, the building houses a small gymnasium that is used for a variety of programs.

Reed Webster Park...

Is located on Warners Road. The park features 2 baseball fields, a pavilion, restroom facility, tennis courts, and a new playground.

Scenic Hills Park...

Is located off of Kasson Road. The park features a picnic shelter and playground equipment.

Warners Park...

Is located on Newport Road. The park features a picnic shelter, a playground and access to the Canal Way Trail.

Erie Canal Park...

Sims Store Museum/Steam Engine Exhibit... The Steam Engine Exhibit contains an engine that was built in 1913 and was used by the L.C. Typewriter Company in their main Syracuse plant, which was redeveloped into Midtown Plaza. The working steam exhibit is open the second Sunday of every month May – October.
