#### **REGISTRATION FORMS**

- Incorrect or incomplete forms and inaccurate payment will result in the return of forms and payment. Corrected forms may be resubmitted. No program spaces will be held. Spaces are filled on a first paid, first served basis. Unfortunately, errors cause time delays and may result in your exclusion from a particular program. The waiver must be signed.
- Registration form is located in this newsletter. Additional forms or online registration is available at camillus.recdesk.com.

#### **PROGRAM FEES**

- Checks, credit cards, money orders or cash are accepted.
- Registrations without all required fees will be returned.
- There will be a \$20 fee for any returned check.
- You may register for some programs after a program has started. However, you will need to pay entire program fee...we do not pro-rate.
- Registrations and fees will not be accepted at any program locations.

#### CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

- Please be sure that you can attend all classes before registering.
- Summer Day Camp refunds differ from below
- Refund requests must come directly to the Parks & Recreation office (not program instructors) at least by the Friday before the program begins and will be charged a \$10.00 processing fee. If a program will not have enough students to run class due to your cancellation, your refund will not be honored. (Credit card processing fees are not refundable). No refunds will be offered after this date unless:
  - 1. The Parks & Recreation Dept. cancels the program.
  - 2. A waiting list exists for a program and someone off of the waiting list can fill the person's spot that has vacated.
  - 3. The request is accompanied by a doctor's written excuse within 2 days of injury (this will be pro-rated at the discretion of the department).
  - 4. Medical refund requests will not be taken after the completion of a program.
  - 5. No refunds will be issued for weather related cancellations.
- Refunds may take up to six weeks to process.
- The Town of Camillus does not assume the responsibility for printing errors.
- Non Refundable deposits will not be returned. Summer Day Camp refunds will only be granted after June 14<sup>th</sup> if the space can be filled from the wait list.

# 2024 Summer Day Camp

Registration is ONLINE ONLY @ camillus.recdesk.com, Monday, May 6, 2024 @ 9:00 AM

For a quicker registration process, be sure to create a family account (parent/guardian and children) prior to registration if you don't have one already. Doing this will save time and frustration at registration. Please register and pay for your Summer Day Camp weeks before adding the parent paperwork to your cart. The parent paperwork is also located on camillus.recdesk.com and called Summer Day Camp Paperwork. You will need to get your child's immunization records asap as they are due by June 7<sup>th</sup>.

This program offers a safe and fun summer experience to enjoy rain or shine! Each week will have a "theme". Weekly activities will vary by day but will include things such as field trips (additional fee) organized games, board games, sports, arts and crafts, theme related activities, talent shows and of course everyone's summer favorite-boondoggle! Parents will receive a schedule at the beginning of each week noting the highlights of each day.

Field trips can be added on at time of registration. If you do not add on field trips at time of registration you will still be able to register up until the Monday prior to the trip. Week 6 field trip to Gillie Lake (no swimming) is mandatory and added on to cost of that week.

What: Summer Day Camp

Who: Entering Grades 1 - 6 (must have completed K - 5 during 2023 - 2024 school year)

Program is only open to residents of the Town of Camillus and/or the West Genesee School District

Where: East Hill Elementary or Onondaga Road Elementary

Time: Half Day- 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM; Full Day- 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM

Fee: Half Day- \$100.00/week, (week of 7/1 - 7/5) will be \$80 and excludes 7/4

Full Day- \$120.00/week, (week of 7/1 - 7/5) will be \$96 and excludes 7/4

When: July 1 - August 9 (excluding July 4)

There will be a choice to pay for weeks in full upon registration or to pay a nonrefundable \$10 fee to hold your spot. If opting for the \$10 deposit to hold a spot, full payment will be due by June 7th in the form of cash or check or cc, along with all camp paperwork. Failure to pay in full and submit all paperwork by June 7<sup>th</sup> will result in losing your child's spot. Refunds will be charged a \$10 fee until June 14<sup>th</sup>. After June 14<sup>th</sup>, there will be no refunds unless your child's spot can be filled from the wait list.

Immunizations are required, if you cannot upload them to your computer, you can submit them to the Parks and Recreation Office and we can upload them for you.




